This powerful software program allows you to submit insurance claims to a virtually limitless number of insurance carriers, as well as to Medicare and Medicaid. Filing electronically not only helps eliminate time-consuming and costly errors, it also significantly decreases your turnaround time for reimbursement, thereby improving your cash flow.

Electronic filing of claims is becoming more and more prevalent, and is being strongly encouraged by insurance companies as well as the government. By the year 2000, it's estimated that 90% of all physicians will file claims electronically. **The Electronic Claims Manager** will give you a step up on this important development in the healthcare industry.



HOW DOES THE ELECTRONIC CLAIMS MANAGER WORK?

The Electronic Claims Manager is a simple, easy-to-use software product that allows you to prepare claims seamlessly through the ICS Practice Management System and submit them electronically to the appropriate insurance carrier(s). Here's how it works:

- You will prepare your claim as usual in your ICS Practice Management System. But instead of printing and submitting a paper claim, you will only need to press a few simple keys to transmit your claim at the end of the day (or at another time convenient for your practice). The transmission will take place over standard telephone lines; no special, expensive telecommunication equipment is needed.
- The claim will first be sent to an ICS-approved clearinghouse where it will undergo a number of comprehensive checks and edits to insure its accuracy and completeness. This checkpoint edits for CPT and diagnostic compatibility to assure maximum accuracy. If any claim is in error, it will be rejected and your screen will indicate that a correction or additional information is needed so you can immediately resubmit the claim. This eliminates the number one reason for delays in reimbursement ... having a claim rejected by the insurance carrier and having to resubmit it.
- Once the claim is complete and accurate, it will be transmitted to the proper carrier. In the rare instance that the company does not accept electronic submission, your claim will be printed and forwarded via first class mail.
- Most claims reach a carrier the same day you prepare them on your system. This speeds up the reimbursement process and improves your cash flow.
